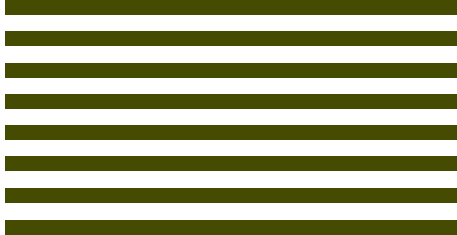

#### COST?

#### CAN I USE MY INS TOO?

No, this is an in-office dental discount plan offered exclusively for our un-insured patients only.

#### WAITING PERIOD?

No, any recommended work can begin right away.

### Limits on how often I can schedule?

*We will collaborate with you on a PLAN that gives you the best possible dental health, with as little time in the chair as possible. We know that you are busy, but our goal is to optimize your dental health WITHOUT the need for multiple scheduled appointments. Any preventive appointments outside of your two standard cleanings and exams, can utilize the 25% courtesy off.*

What if I need a periodontal related cleaning? Does this count as part of my two cleanings?

The 25% courtesy is applied towards perio cleanings, known as Perio Maintenance or Deep scaling appointments.

### EXCLUSIONS?

In-office whitening, custom bleach trays, whitening refills, FL2 pastes, rinses, and serums.
